screen is now accessible by pressing Menu and arrowing over to it.


Also, while in the guide the Restart icon now shows as a green Watch from Start button at the bottom of the screen. If Restart is not available, the green button will not display.

### SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE TO JVT MEMBERS

The South Dakota
Telecommunications Association
(SDTA) is now accepting applications
for the Brian Meyer Memorial
Scholarship. Two scholarships in
the amounts of \$1,250 and \$500
will be awarded for the 2020 spring
semester.

The scholarship is available to applicants who have completed at least 24 credit hours of post-secondary instruction (includes high school 'dual credit' hours) towards a multi-year program degree at any accredited technical schools or other accredited post-secondary higher education institution in South Dakota. The applicant or applicant's legal guardian must be a subscriber of an SDTA member company.

Applicants must complete an application, the student information and essay questions, a minimum of two letters of recommendation must accompany the application along with an unofficial transcript. The deadline to submit an application for the Brian Meyer Memorial Scholarship is October 31. Selection of awards will be announced by mid-December.
