Android Features to Start Using Today

Kim Komando has long been a technology expert and according to her website, there are a few features and options on your cell phone that you should start using. These aren't necessarily the newest or fanciest features, but each one can be quite useful.

Adjusting the Quick Settings panel

If you like to toggle features on your phone around often, you don't have to return to the settings app every time. You can remove a step or two by changing your settings through the Quick Settings feature.

To find Quick Settings, swipe down from the top of your screen. This will show you the first few settings. To view more, swipe down again. You can also change what you see in Quick Settings in a few easy steps: From the top of your screen, swipe down twice. Press Edit at the bottom left. Touch and hold the setting and move it where you want. To add a setting, drag it up where you want it to be.

Google Assistant

Many have seen this on their phone, some already use it. There are so many things you can do with it


including using your voice for your alarm, access Interpreter Mode to understand another language, send an audio message to someone, or just have a location based reminder pop up when you're in the grocery store.

To access your assistant, press and hold your home button. Swipe up and tap "Get Started."

Bedtime and Focus Mode

Both Bedtime and Focus mode are part of the Android Digital Wellbeing campaign aimed at helping you live a healthier life. With so many apps on our phones, it's easy to get distracted. Focus mode allows you to pause apps temporarily or even set a schedule. Bedtime Mode helps you switch off by turning your screen to grayscale automatically or when you charge your phone. You can access both in Settings or the Digital Wellbeing dashboard.

These are just a few Android features. We suggest searching online or watching videos anytime you get a new phone. There's always something interesting to learn!
