2023 Bob Peterson Memorial Telecommunications Scholarship

James Valley Telecommunications will be awarding three \$2,000 scholarships this school year to area seniors whose parents or legal guardians are members of the cooperative.

Scholarship applications have been forwarded to the guidance counselors at area schools. Applications are also available online at www.jamesvalley.com.

The deadline for returning an application to James Valley Telecommunication's office is February 28, 2023. All applications must be received in the office by that date to be considered.

Seniors must be attending an accredited college, university or vocational school in South Dakota in the fall of 2023. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required. As part of the application process, all applicants must submit an essay of 400 words or less on the topic, "If you could thank anyone for their guidance and support throughout your high school years, who would it be and why?"

JVT members can also apply for the Foundation for Rural Service (FRS) scholarship. Requirements and application instructions are available at frs.org.





JVT/NVC Cell Network Upgrade

If your phone or SIM card needs to be swapped out, you have already been contacted via phone call or text message. If you have been contacted and not stopped in yet – please do so! If your phone is up to date the process should only take a few minutes! To make sure your phone is up to date you can browse to settings on your phone and select Software Update. Click on Download and install. It should say your software is up to date.

Benefits of upgrading to VoLTE include:


•Better in network coverage – We have replaced four cell sites with brand new towers and added two additional towers to fill in coverage gaps.

- •Better out of network coverage CDMA voice roaming will not exist at the end of the year, upgrading will allow for voice calls to work when roaming.
- •Faster call connection Voice over the LTE network allows for faster call connections and text message delivery.
- •Improved voice quality We have added new and improved HD voice codecs and unified all voice services with VoLTE technology.
- •Ability to use GPS while on a call VoLTE allows for simultaneous voice and data connections.

JVT/NVC Supports Local Schools

One of the benefits of doing business with JVT/ NVC is that we provide support to your local school districts through a variety of sponsorships and donations, and through the payment of gross receipts taxes.

Each year we pay gross receipts taxes on all of the revenue that the company collects. These taxes are then distributed to the school districts in each of the counties where the revenue was generated.

In 2022, JVT/NVC paid \$353,408.15 in 2021 gross receipts to thirteen school districts. When making decisions about your telecommunications purchases, take into consideration whether the company is a local entity such as JVT/NVC who provides monetary support each year to the schools in its service area, or whether it is, in fact, a national or regional company who does not provide such tax payouts.
